How does the wavelength of a higher pitch note compare (smaller, larger, same) to that of lower pitch note? Explain your answer.

- 1. Smaller for higher pitch.  $v = \lambda f$ .
- 2. Higher for higher pitch.

You stand alongside a railroad and a train approaches and passes while blowing its whistle. What happens to the pitch (frequency) of the sound as the train passes (stay constant, increase or decrease)? Explain your answer.

- 1. Decreases. Doppler effect.
- 2. Decreases. Distance increases.
- 3. Constant. Speed and frequency are constant.
- 4. Increases. Doppler effect.
