

Snowshoe Etiquette On Groomed Trails

at Skyway & CountyLine on Grand Mesa



Snowshoe on the far edge of the Skating Lane (not in the middle), on the opposite side of the Classic Tracks. Do not snowshoe on the Classic Tracks!

Skate Skiers be considerate of slower people. Do not skate over the Classic Track.

Classic Skiers ski in the Classic Tracks. When you Herring Bone up a hill or snowplow down, move into the Skating Lane to preserve the groomed Classic Track for the next skier.
